## Video trails to let nature speak for itself

Interactive trails can deliver important narratives, in the places where they matter, immersing visitors in the story of the landcape and experiential learning. Video or animation is revealed by static signage that will appeal to people's imagination.

## How can they help? Some ideas:

- Illustrate the natural history of a site, the important habitats and creatures that live there.
- Tell people more about your land management methods, e.g. rewilding principles
- Reveal the animals that come out at night or hide from human view
- Point out some of the tinier creatures that may go unnoticed
- Deliver the country code in a more persuasive and agreeable way
- Introduce poetry, creative writing or art related to the landscape
- Explain natural processes, such as life cycles or food chains.
- Link to webcams on site, or crowd data provided by the community.
